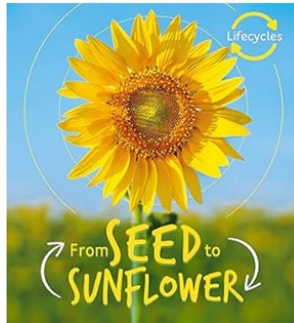

Key books for this half term:

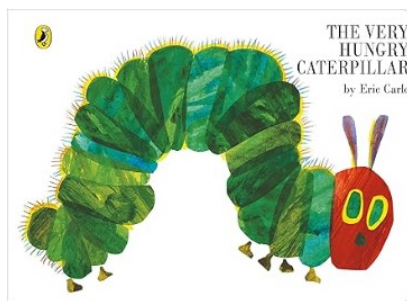


What is a sunflower?

Roots, stems, plants, cold, dry, golden, yellow, petals, sunlight, grow, water, soil, leaf, stem,



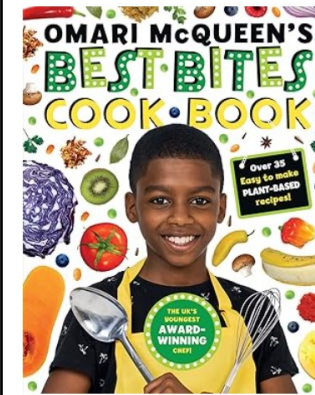
The very hungry caterpillar

Key vocabulary:

Recipe, instructions, ingredients, first, next, after that, mix, stir, grate, pour, tip, knead, dough, spread, bake

Learning experiences: PSED

Create a display of beautiful unique flowers to show how we are all different. Children could paint, collage or craft a flower that is unique to them, but belongs in the flowerbed display with all of the other individual flowers.

When handling plants, soil or using the outdoor area, use the opportunity to remind children about cleanliness and hand hygiene.
