



## Year 6 The First World War

What was the impact of WWI on our local area?

At Merridale, history, geography, art and design and technology are taught through a topic based approach which we call discover.

### History

In History, we will extend our historical knowledge beyond 1066. We will look at the causes of WWI. Then, we will learn about the daily life of the soldiers in the trenches and how men were persuaded to join the army. In addition, we will learn about the important role animals played in WWI. They look at the impact WWI had on the local area through the lives of local soldiers and factories. In addition, we will see how WWI impacted the development of aircraft.

Franz Ferdinand      The Wright brothers      Walter Tull

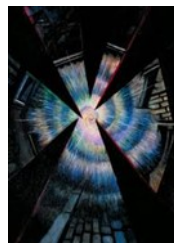
### Geography

In geography, children will be focusing on the continent of Europe. We will build on our locational knowledge when learning what countries make up Europe. In particular, we will be exploring how the geography of Europe and bordering countries has changed since WWI. Our target is to be able to label as many countries in Europe as possible!

They will learn about the physical features of Europe and name the major mountain ranges. The children will also explore Europe's climate.

### Art and Design

Children will study the work of Christopher Nevinson and the Futurism and Cubism art movements. They will identify features of these styles and create their own versions. They will develop their skills using acrylic paint and comparing this to watercolour. We will then experiment blending using different brush strokes to create a desired effect.
