Geography


In geography, children will locate Jamaica on a world map and learn the names of the 5 oceans.

They will learn about the physical and human features of Jamaica and compare them to the UK.



They will look at the weather and climate of Jamaica and compare it to that of the UK.

Children will study the work of Judy Ann Macmillan. They will identify features of her artwork and create their own versions of still life.
