



Year 4 Where we Live

At Merridale, history, geography, art and design and technology are taught through a topic based approach which we call discover.

History

In History, children will about how waterways were used in the past and why Wolverhampton has so many canals.

Geography

In geography, children will learn what a county is and which county we live in. They will identify and locate major cities within the UK.



Children will learn about the different parts of a river, the longest river in the UK and the journey of this river.

When at Carding Mill Valley, children will carry out a range of field work activities as well as looking at the differences between Wolverhampton and Carding Mill Valley.

Art and Design

Children will study the work of David Hockney. They will identify features of his artwork and create their own versions using paint. They will develop their understanding of a foreground and background as well as the sizes of these, They will learn how to mix paints to create secondary colours and will understand that different brushes create different thickness of lines.
