All secondary schools in Wolverhampton provide numerous opportunities for you and your child to visit before expressing a preference. Please check the websites of any schools that you are interested in to find out more about open evenings, events and visits. We encourage parents, carers and children to visit settings to gain an insight on how they might best support your child. We will always authorise these visits as long as you inform us in advance.

All applications must be made online via The City of Wolverhampton Parents Porta:

Citizen Portal - Sign in (wolverhampton.gov.uk)

You are allowed to express a preference for five schools. Due to the popularity of Wolverhampton schools, you are encouraged to use all five preferences.

Applications must be made by the national closing date for applications of **31 October 2023**. Making an application after the closing date can reduce the chance of your child gaining a place at one of your preferred school choices but please be aware that making your application **BEFORE** the closing date does not increase your chances of gaining a place in your chosen school. We urge you to take your time, find out as much information as you can by visiting local schools as well as attending the meeting at Merridale on 18th September **BEFORE** submitting your child's application.
