Reception to Year 6 Children can come straight into the school building between 8.40am and 8.50am each morning where they will be supervised by school staff. From 8.50am, children must enter school through the main office at the front of the building and they will be classed as late.

Our attendance policy states that we are unable to authorise any absence for family holiday, trips or visits. Patterns of poor attendance and punctuality will be followed-up by the school's educational welfare officer to look at ways of reducing these instances. If you require any support with these areas, please do not hesitate to contact the school.
