For our next unit of work we will be titled:

"Jamaica"

This will encompass many aspects of the curriculum but its main focus is around Geography.. Children will learn about Jamaica and it's location as well as looking at its physical features.

This booklet contains a list of activities linked to our learning in the classroom. Pupils can choose which activities they would like to complete (they do not need to be completed in the order presented here), They may do as many activities as they would like over the course of the term and record them in their new "Discover Homework" book. Children will be rewarded for every piece of work they complete.

These tasks will draw on a range of skills including ICT, Literacy, Numeracy, Music, Drama, Art, Science and Design and Technology skills.

Children are also encouraged to create their own ideas for projects, there is space to record these on the back page of this booklet.

Suggested tasks and activities (tick when completed):

- Find and locate Jamaica in an atlas or on a globe. Look at the countries around it. Where is it close to? Can you find the U.K. Is Jamaica near or far?
 - Print a copy of the world. Label Jamaica and the U.K. can you label the oceans in between and the surrounding countries? Can you find out the name of the continents?
 - Research the Jamaican flag. Can you create your own version of it? Could you use a range of media for example paints, felts, crayons or collage?
 - Jamaica has a very different climate to us. Can you find out about it? Can you make a graph showing the temperatures throughout the year?
 - Jamaica has many tourist attractions. Can you find out what they are? Could you create a holiday brochure or poster giving details of these places?
 - Can you paint a picture of the landscape of Jamaica?
 - Pretend you are in Jamaica and write a postcard home about what it is like to be there.
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
