Research famous Ancient Egyptian inventions and present the information in any way you wish e.g poster, report, etc


Create an information text explaining who the Greek Gods and Goddesses were and their special powers.

This booklet contains a list of activities linked to our class topic “**Time travellers: Ancient Civilisations**”. Pupils can choose which activities they would like to complete (they do not need to be completed in the order presented here). Pupils may do as many activities as they would like over the course of the term.

This learning journal has been designed to encourage pupils to work independently (outside of school) and with parents and carers to complete tasks based on areas being studied at school. Children should complete these tasks in their Discovery Homework book.

These tasks will draw on a range of skills including ICT, Literacy, Numeracy, Music, Drama, Art, Science and Design and Technology skills.

Once children have completed a task they should bring it into their teacher to receive recognition on the class record chart.

Children are also encouraged to create their own ideas for projects and there is space to record these on the back page of this booklet.

Suggested tasks and activities (tick when completed):

Create a world history timeline, including the Ancient Egyptian and Ancient Greek periods.

Draw/paint a picture of something from Ancient Egypt/ Ancient Greece e.g. one of the Greek Gods, a pyramid, some hieroglyphics. or the Parthenon. Write a caption to go with it.

Create your own Ancient Greek Olympic game— you can use the games they actually played to help you.

Make a 3d model of a mummy

Conduct some research about Alexander the Great and write a short biography of him.

Write a diary entry from the point of view of an Ancient Greece citizen.

Write a secret message to your friend using the Greek alphabet— be careful as not all of the letters of the English alphabet are there.
